Secretary proposed obtaining company/firm sponsors for banner ads on website to help pay cost of web hosting

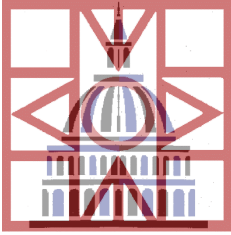
Officers and members are urged to utilize the message board on the website to start dialogue and encourage interaction amongst the community
